- Approve a policy to require \$100 / \$25 non-refundable deposit for all trips Motion to require a \$100 deposit to secure a spot on each trip with up to 50% non-refundable. Motion: Donohue, Second: Palumbo, carried. Discussion: within this deposit structure we need to be flexible and take each request for a refund on a case-by-case.

New Business:

Discussion: Has Livingston CARES approached Sponsored Research in seeking grants? Yes, but it is currently not a priority. We should think about utilizing that office when appropriate. Our donations come in from a range of places and for restricted and unrestricted funds so not always appropriate to utilize Sponsored Research but a good thing to keep in mind.
